

# Horseback Riding at Cataloochee Ranch

Group rides are Wednesday-Saturday at 10 a.m. and Sunday at 2 p.m. Rides are not available on Mondays and Tuesdays. All rides are guided. Prices include gratuity for the wrangler. All charges will be applied to your room.

## **Half Day Group Ride • 2.5 hours**

Arrival time: 9:30 a.m. Ride at 10 a.m.

**Single Rider: \$150**

***Each Additional Rider: \$100***

## **Half Day Private Ride • 2.5 hours**

Arrival time: 30 minutes prior to ride

**Single Rider: \$250**

***Each Additional Rider: \$150***

## **All Day Group Ride • 5-6 hours**

*Includes bag lunch from The Swag*

Arrival time: 9:30 a.m. Ride at 10 a.m.

**Single Rider: \$350**

***Each Additional Rider: \$200***

## **All Day Private Ride • 5-6 hours**

*Includes bag lunch from The Swag*

Arrival time: 30 minutes prior to ride

**Single Rider: \$500**

***Each Additional Rider: \$250***

## **Ready to Book?**

Please contact Guest Services with the day and ride you are interested in. At the time of reservation we will ask for each rider's name, age, height, weight, and riding ability. Riding ability is based on the rider's experience level, not the terrain. All level of rider's (from first time riders to advanced) may be on the same ride. We assign the horse to the guest based on their riding ability. **For safety purposes, we stress that guests do not overstate their ability to ride.**

**First Time Rider:** Never been on a horse.

**Beginner Rider:** The beginner rider has ridden more than one time. He/she may need guidance from the wrangler in certain situations.

**Intermediate Rider:** Feels comfortable riding, turning and stopping their horse.

**Advanced Rider:** Feels comfortable riding, turning, stopping their horse. The advanced rider will be expected to maintain control of their advanced horse in all situations.

## **Additional Information**

- Children must be 8 years old, weigh at least 50 lbs. to ride. Minimum age for an All-Day rider is 12 years old. Children 12 and under must wear a helmet (we provide).
- Maximum number of riders per ride is 6.
- We have some gaited horses.
- We ride in the rain and provide rain gear. We do not ride during thunderstorms. If a thunderstorm comes up while on the trail, we will come back to the barn as quickly as possible. If a thunderstorm comes up before the ride goes out, we will wait 30 minutes to see if the weather clears before canceling the ride.
